## The Etymology and History of Culinary Names from Betawi Dwi Putri Ningsih

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Betawi is a tribe that lives in Jakarta, the capital city of Indonesia. Betawi tribe is well known for their tradition, including their foods and drinks. The Naming of Betawinese food is also important to be known.
